A. GENERAL PRESENTATION OF THE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE 1: Building of BePangea

It has been built between the members to the actual status an Association registered according to the 1st. of July 1901 act and to the 16th. of august 1901 decree, whose title is BePangea.

ARTICLE 2: Association matters

1. The Association works as a Non Government Organisation (NGO) and without lucrative purpose to the development and maintenance of an international fair trade showing solidarity between the members, and according to the forms described in the Charter and with its appended regulations.
2. The Association sets up and manages without lucrative purpose buying and selling trade solutions of products or services as an alternative to traditional trade working together with local Actions groups and NGOs or active networks in the frame of humanitarian, social and lasting development.
3. The Association participates to national and international trade exchanges in order to make profits to be repaid to humanitarian, social or lasting development actions.
4. The Association participates and manages production solutions together with humanitarian, social or lasting development actions.
5. The Association participates to humanitarian, social or lasting development actions together with NGOs or active networks in these fields.
6. The Association gives Certifications to products and to producers participating to a humanitarian, social or lasting development.
7. The Association repays to NGOs or to humanitarian, social or lasting development actions the profits made according to the conformity to the Charter and to its Regulations.

ARTICLE 3: registered office

The registered office is in Veigy-Foncenex in the French department Haute Savoie. It can be transferred by simple decision of the Direction or of the International Committee.

ARTICLE 4: Geographical extensions of the activities of the Association and corresponding designations.

The Association extends its activities on a national and international field.

1. when it acts as top international organization, the Association is named **BePangea International**.
2. when its acts as national section, it is named **BePangea** followed by the **name of the country**.
3. In France, its national activities are organised under the name of **BePangea France**.

ARTICLE 5: Other designation of the Association for certifications

The Association uses the designation of **BePangea Certification** in operations bound to products or producers certification.

ARTICLE 6: Length of the Association

The length of the Association is unlimited.

B. REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 7: Basic regulations

The basic regulations of BePangea are :

1. the actual Status,
2. The Charter and the appended regulations,
3. the inner regulations,
4. the financial regulations.

The « trade commitments » complete these regulations.

ARTICLE 8: joined regulations

Other regulations are completing the basic regulations in order to answer to various necessities.

These regulations are published to the attention of the members and of the eligible parties on the reserved place of the Internet site.

ARTICLE 9: publication of regulations

The status and the Charter and their connected regulations are published on the principal Internet site of the Association.

C. INTERNATIONAL REPRESENTATIONS OF THE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE 10: national sections types

The national sections are under three distinct forms :

1. the sections constituted in national NGO or a similar form according to the legislation of the country,
2. the so-called representative sections which are not constituted in juridical structure but have a complete structure according to the definition described in the status,
3. the so-called simple sections where the members are under the indirect direction of BePangea International.

ARTICLE 11: constitution of national sections and their autonomy levels

1. A simple national section exists automatically as soon as members of a country have registered in BePangea, Its working is entirely ruled by the status and BePangea regulations according to the corresponding national regulations.
2. On a decision of the Association board composed of the Direction and of the International Committee, a simple section can be changed into a national section so-called representative.

It has then an autonomy level enabling it to organize its activities inside foreseen limits.

It may full fill the inner regulations according to its needs under the control of the International Direction and the International Committee.

It has rights and duties described in the status and the inner regulation.

Its runs it own bookkeeping and is financially independent from BePangea.

The financial and juridical responsibility of BePangea is limited in this respect.

3. A representative national section, on decision of the Administration board composed of the International Direction and Committee, with the approval of the local direction, may be organized into an independent NGO or under an adapted form according to the legislation of the country. It is then a so-called constituted section.

It has a full autonomy limited to the only respect of the Charter, its appended regulations, of the inner BePangea regulation and of the executive power of Committee of Ethic.

The financial and juridical reponsability of BePangea is not any more committed, unless particular disposition.

D. STRUCTURE OF THE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE 12: Members of the Association

Are members of the Association:

- persons joining the Association,
- NGOs or active organizations in the field of human and lasting development having joined BePangea,
- commercial societies having joined BePangea,
- producers or buyers having joined BePangea,
- Elected persons to the Committee of Ethic.

To join BePangea all personal members, producers, buyers or companies must have had validated the Charter of the Association and have been agreed by the national section or by BePangea International.

The way to join BePangea can be found and made on Internet or in writing, without country restrictions.

ARTICLE 13: The Board of Directors

The Board of Directors is constituted of a Direction of 2 persons at least and of an International Committee.

The Direction and the International Committee shares equally the general management. The Direction has a right of veto on the decisions.

Are members of the Direction the Founder and all persons designated by the Board of Directors and the International Committee according to the significant contribution they brought to the management of BePangea.

Are members of the International Committed all persons named by all the Direction and the International Committee according to the significant contribution they bring to the management of BePangea and each President of a national representative or constituted section.

The Board of Directors constitutes the direction of BePangea International.

ARTICLE 14: BePangea International

BePangea appoints the whole direction, sections and members working at an international level, as well as national branches working in simple sections.

The BePangea organization is governed by the inner regulations.

The national members non-organized in a representative or constituted section are considered as being part of BePangea International.

ARTICLE 15: Simple sections

The national simple sections are bound to BePangea International and gather all the members of a country.

They are governed and directed by the Directors of the Board.

A Direction or a National Committee can be constituted on the decision of the Directors of the Board designating their members.

ARTICLE 16: the representative national sections

The national and representative sections are constituted by all the members of the countries.

The direction of a representative national section is constituted of one Direction of at least 2 persons and of a National Committee.

Are members of the Direction a person from the Board of Directors of BePangea International and the persons named by the whole National Direction and the National Committee, according to the significant contribution they bring to the management of BePangea.

Are members of the National Committee the persons named by the whole National Direction and the National Committee according to the significant contribution they bring to the management of BePangea.

The use foresees that the NGOs or outer affiliated organizations responsables could have a member sitting to the National Committee.

The National Direction and Committee shares equally the direction. The Direction has a right of veto on the decisions.

Each representative section names a President and a Secretary.

Each representative section is financially independent and is responsible for the operations it governs.

ARTICLE 17: the constituted national sections

The composition of the constituted national sections into an independent NGO or into a juridical assimilated identity is no longer governed by the regulations of BePangea and depends on the legislations of the country which is concerned with the exception of the obligation to include in the direction a member of the Board of Directors of BePangea International other than a member from their section and must have their status validated by the Board of Directors of BePangea International.

The status of a constituted national section must:

- integrate the objects of BePangea,
- Integrate the Charter of BePangea and its appended regulations,
- To refer clearly to BePangea.

It is wishable for coherence and administration reasons that the chosen composition would be similar to those of the of the representative sections of BePangea.

Each constituted section is financially independent and responsible for the operations it controls.

ARTICLE 18: structure adaptations of the sections to national legislations and creation of trading structure or collaboration with existing trading structures.

In the countries where the execution of trading operations is not allowed in the frame of a NGO, that part of activity may be transferred unless national legal dispositions would be opposed:

- to a trading company created in this purpose,
- to a trading company of a third country having already created in the same purpose and having international actions possibilities.
- or to any other form of structure approved by the national section of and by BePangea International.

An inner regulation to the section, approved by BePangea International and filed to the registred office will specify the means of collaboration between BePangea and the chosen identity.

If a trading company is created in this purpose:

- it would include in its own status significant elements of BePangea and will have them validated par the Board of Directors before their registration,
- it would include to its own Board if Directors at least one member belonging to the International or national of BePangea.

ARTICLE 19: Actions groups or networks

The term of Actions group or Network designates all the members involved in the management and the activities of BePangea. Any member of BePangea is automatically member of an Action group.

The administration of Action groups is carried out in priority with computer tools put at their disposal by the Association.

Actions groups are split in national groups directly bound to corresponding sections.

The decision mechanisms and responsibilities are hierarchically and organised according to inner regulation.

ARTICLE 20: NGOs or affiliated organizations

The NGOs or affiliated organizations have a right to elect one of their directing members to the National Committee in the country where they have a significant action with BePangea.

The NGOs or affiliated organizations have a right of management or organization at an Action groups level when they are directly related with their actions. This right is shared with BePangea according to the inner regulation and the logic of the situation.

ARTICLE 21: Comity of Ethic

The Comity of Ethic is constituted at least of three persons strictly independent from the trading operations of BePangea.

The quality of member of the Committee of Ethic is available:

- by qualification submitted to the approval of the relative majority of the Board of Directors,
- or by application submitted to the approval of the relative majority of all the members of the directions of the national sections being expressed in a vote.

The application to the Committee of Ethic is opened to persons outside of BePangea.

The Committee of Ethic is acting as a control organization according to the status , to the Charter and inner regulations.

E. RUNNING OF THE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE 22: Role of the Board of Directors

The Board of Directors is invested of extended powers in the limit of the object of the Association and the exclusive powers reserved to constituted sections at the General Assembly and at the Committee of Ethic.

Roles bound to regulations

It is the only responsible of the writing of the Status, of the inner Regulation, of the Financial Regulation and of the structure of the Organization.

Roles of Direction

It has a right to direct BePangea International, the simple sections, and a right shared on all the national structures according to the Status, the organization and the inner regulation.

To intervene and decide in case of dispute at sections level.

It has a right of veto on operations led by the national sections.

The Board of Directors is authorised to require and execute local operations or ground operations together with national sections.

Other roles

The board of Directors names the leader executives working at BePangea International.

Its names a President and a Secretary among its members.

The Board of Directors holds the official register of decisions and modifications.

It organizes polls to the Committee of Ethic in case applications would be submitted.

It asks to attend an ordinary general assembly each year at least or a general Assembly if necessary.

ARTICLE 23: the ordinary general assembly

The ordinary general assembly gathers the decisions of the members of the Board of Directors and of the Committee of Ethic

Because of the international character of the Association, the general assembly may be held in using the informatic communication tools made to enable the member to study the objects and to express themselves in their decisions.

It:

- approves the regulations including the Charter and its appended regulations
- take decisions concerning the general strategy,
- is the only one able to named the representative sections and to allow the promotion of a section into a constituted unit,
- is the one only able to exclude a national section,
- can exclude a member of the Committee of Ethic,
- approve the bookkeeping of BePangea International,
- elect the members of General Direction,
- elect the members and the Secretary among its members,
- is the only one organization able to dissolve the Association.

To validate its deliberations it is necessary that at least half of the members of Board of Directors had expressed itself.

Is the quorum is not reached, the Ordinary Assembly is again summoned after a fifteen days delay.

It can deliberate whatever be the number of members having expressed themselves.

The deliberations are taken by the majority of the members having expressed

ARTICLE 24: The extraordinary general assembly

The extraordinary general assembly gathers the decisions of all members of the Board of Directors and of the Committee of Ethic in case of a particular demand

Its other characteristic and means are similar to these of the ordinary general assembly.

ARTICLE 25: Functioning of simple national sections

The functioning of simple national sections is organized and directed by the Board of Directors.

In case where a Direction or a National Committee are created, the limits of their actions and organization of their members are decided par the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE 26: Functioning of the representative national sections

The functioning of the representative national sections is submitted to the various regulations of BePangea .

They have the power of organization and management on a national field under the supervision of BePangea International, including the organization of local development actions.

They can require or organize the granting of funds intended for actions conformed to the objects of the Association and to its Charter.

ARTICLE 27: Role of the direction of the national representative sections

The direction of the representative sections is invested of powers of organization and management on a national field under the supervision of BePangea International in the limits of the objects of the Association, of the Charter, and others regulations and executive powers of the general assembly and the Committee of Ethic.

It has in particular a right of shared management on the financial operations and on the members under its direct control, together with the affiliated NGOs if this right is applicable to shared actions.

It proposes its own modalities of financial management which are imperatively validated by the Board of Directors.

The direction of representative sections has its own register of decisions and its own bookkeeping which must communicated to the Board of Directors each year.

The representative sections are free to hold their own general assembly.

ARTICLE 28: Functioning of the collaboration with the constituted national sections

The constituted national sections establish a distinction between the actions depending of their own area of responsibility and those made in collaboration with BePangea International.

The first are made in accordance with the objects of the Association and its Charter without other restrictions.

The second are submitted to regulations and to the supervision of BePangea.

ARTICLE 29: functioning of Actions groups

The functioning of the Actions group is governed by the various regulations of BePangea.

Each member is directly placed under the control and the responsibility of the superior hierarchical authorities, more often the local section.

ARTICLE 30: functioning of the Committee of Ethic

The Committee of Ethic elects a President whose mandate is renewed each year during its own Assembly.

The Committee of Ethic establishes its own functioning rules.

F. ORGANIZATIONS OF CONTROL

ARTICLE 31: role of the Committee of Ethic

The Committee of Ethic works together with the Board of Director to the redaction of the Charter and its appended Regulations. The decisions are taken at the majority of the members.

Its acts as control organization on the determination of the financial part reserved to fair trade, to NGOs, to the affiliated organization or to development actions related to trading operations.

It acts as control and appeal organization on the financial repartition on the part reserved to fair trade, to NGOs, to the affiliated organizations or to development actions related to trading operations.

It acts as control organization on the amounts of remunerations of the commissions.

It acts as control organization on the distribution of netto profits of BePangea.

It acts as top organization of friendly agreement of inner disputes on the current affairs in case the Board of Directors could not do it.

It participates if it wishes to the management of reserve funds for development actions or supports to disadvantaged producers.

The Committee of Ethic decides according to the Charter and its appended regulations.

ARTICLE 32: extend of powers of the Committee of Ethic

The Committee of Ethic has an upper right to that of the Board of Directors when its deals with an appeal.

The Committee of Ethic has a free right of publication on the main Internet site of the Association in the limit of its competence without other control but that of its own majority represented by its President.

It has a right to bring to court BePangea or its actions in respect to its attributed rights of control.

ARTICLE 33: financial control organization

When the financial means allow it, BePangea names a independent financial control organization in charge of verifying any misuse or fraud related to the objects of the Association and its Charter.

G. MEANS AND FINANCIAL MANGEMENTS OF THE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE 34: means of the Association

The means of the Association are composed of :

- from shares deducted from the trading operations of the companies,
- from shared deducted from trading operations made on its Internet sites, from profits on the organised events,
- from interests or licence fee on properties it may own,
- from various remunerations of services done or organization of events by the Association,
- from donations,
- from public grants,
- from private investments,
- from subscriptions,
- from the direct sales of products,
- from all other kinds permitted by the law, particularly the possibility when necessary to one or several banking or private loans.

ARTICLE 35: financial organization

The inner regulation determines the organization, financial, managerial and financial distribution clauses between the parties according to the following principles:

- each national representative or constituted section is economically independent,
- the allocated means are bound to the financial volumes of the operations negotiated and to the respective cost of life between the parties and BePangea,
- the allocated means are bound to separate costs,
- the allocated means can be adapted to exceptional local needs or to the fulfilment of specific actions under the decision of the Board of Directors,
- each trading operation made refers to a mechanism of allocations in accordance with the objects of the Association.

ARTICLE 36: constitution of provisions

BePangea constitutes the financial provisions necessary to Association and the correct development of its trading operations.

This management is under the only responsibility of the Board of Directors and cannot be appealed by the Committee of Ethic.

ARTICLE 37: constitution of reserves

BePangea constitutes the necessary reserves to maintain and secure the continuation of its activities.

The maximum amount of reserves is fixed in the inner regulation according to the global financial movements.

This management is under the only responsibility of the Board of Directors and cannot be appealed by the Committee of Ethic.

ARTICLE 38: constitution of a reserve fund for the actions of development or support to disadvantaged producers

BePangea constitutes a financial reserve fund necessary to launch and maintain development actions, to launch or support local productions and support disadvantages producers.

This fund can be used to make donations to NGOs.

This reserve fund can be supplied by deduction taken on trading operations or by any other means according to the regulation.

This management can be entrusted to the Board of Directors, to national constituted sections or to the Committee of Ethic in case its wishes to give an advice.

H. REMUNERATIONS, COMMISSIONS AND FINANCIAL RETROCESSIONS TO THE NGOS.

ARTICLE 39: voluntary work

The voluntary work of members of the staff is accepted if required by the conditions of the Association.

The members of the Committee of Ethic are working on voluntary basis.

ARTICLE 40: personal commitment

BePangea recruits staff if necessary and if the budgets allow it according to the local regulations.

ARTICLE 41: remunerations

Remuneration to the direction members

The work of the Board of Director members or of the national sections are voluntary and not remunerated if the conditions of the Association requires it.

They are remunerated up to the SMIC or to the minimum national in all other cases.

Remuneration of all other tasks

Others works are remunerated according to the accomplish tasks, to the specifications, to the responsibility, to the number of working hours according to the usual conditions in the country which the person depends on.

This disposition is applied to the staff other than those acting in the direction.

This measure applies to the members possessing managerial functions as far as the accomplished tasks do not appear in the specifications of the execution of their function such as it is described by the present statuts.

The amount of the remunerations is submitted to the powers of control of the Committee of Ethic.

ARTICLE 42: commissions

The commissioning on trading operations are included in the repartition mechanisms.

They are on behalf of:

- intervening parties outside of BePangea,
- companies or NGOs,
- members in case their works is not remunerated or weakly remunerated,
- BePangea and his sections,
- other intervening parties in case the practice requires it.

The amount of these commissions will remain compatible with the mission of the Association and will not be mentioned in the frame of informations published on trading operations made by BePangea in accordance with its Charter.

The amount of commissions is submitted to the powers of control of the Committee of Ethic.

ARTICLE 43: in charge of paying remunerations and commissions

The national representative or constituted sections are responsible of the payment of remunerations and commissions according to the inner regulations.

In case of lack of national section, BePangea International assumes this responsibility.

ARTICLE 44: details concerning the management of remunerations and commissions

The detail of the management of the remunerations and commissions is governed by the inner regulation and by the financial regulation under the control of the Committee of Ethic.

ARTICLE 45: financial retrocessions to NGOs

The mechanisms of repartition used in trading operations foresees a part of financial retrocession to the NGO concerned by the transaction.

In case no NGO is concerned by the operation, this part makes up the part falling to the Reserve Fund of BePangea for actions or support to disadvantaged producers. This retrocession is usually made by donation.

These mechanisms are submitted to the Committee of Ethic.

I. PUBLICATION OF INFORMATIONS

ARTICLE 46: publication of amounts allocated to NGOs, to humanitarian operations and support or invested in an action of development.

BePangea publishes the amounts allocated to NGOs, to operations of humanitarian supports or invested in a development action on at least one of the Internet sites.

ARTICLE 47: Publication of informations relative to fair trade

BePangea publishes informations related to fair trade operations on at least one Internet site.

ARTICLE 48: results publication

BePangea commits itself to publish on its Internet site informations concerning its financial results when the yearly global volume of its transactions will have reached the threshold of five millions €.

The informations published will contain at least the minimum amounts:

- of realised transactions
- of direct buyings and sales of the products
- of running expenses
- or remunerations and commissions
- of investments
- of provisions. Reserve and funds for actions of development
- of various supports.

J. DISTRIBUTION OF PROFITS

ARTICLE 49: distribution of profits

The profits made are attributed according to the actual Status, to the Charter and to the inner regulation.

K. TREATMENT OF DISPUTES

ARTICLE 50: treatment of inner disputes other than those concerning constituted sections

The inner disputes are the area of responsibility of the direct hierarchy according to the actual status, to the regulations of the Association, to the Charter and its related regulations as well as its other regulations.

The Board of Directors is the reference for usual resort.

In case of impossibility of the Board of Directors or of resort against this last one, the Committee of Ethic becomes the representative resort treating the case according to the inner adequacy regulation.

ARTICLE 51: treatment of inner disputes to constituted sections

The inner disputes to constituted sections are settled according to their own regulation without the intervention of any instance of BePangea.

If their regulation foresees it, they may mandate BePangea as resort reference.

In case of dispute opposing a section to BePangea on issues depending on its participation to common activities, the regulation of the Association prevails on its own regulation.

ARTICLE 52: possibilities of outer resort

Inner disputes finding no inner solution are submitted by order of priority, except different national legislation:

- to juridical instances of the country of the section
- to juridical French instances.

ARTICLE 53: outer disputes and legal tribunals

In case the juridical tribunal is that of BePangea, the outer disputes which have not been settled through a negotiation are submitted to juridical tribunals by order of priority, unless different national legislation :

- jurisdictions of the country of the section
- French jurisdictions
- resort jurisdiction according to the legislation of the country or French.

ARTICLE 54: responsibilities of members in the frame of a work made in an Actions section

The responsibility of remunerated or commissioned members of the staff is determined by their specification of the inner regulation and by the regulation of the country to which the section is affiliated, if the section is representative or constituted.

The responsibility of non remunerated or non commissioned members not acting as sales persons or buyers or under any other form is assumed by the direct representative or constituted national section if any. In other cases, the responsibility is treated at section level.

The responsibility of members acting as sale persons, producers, buyers, company, NGO or under any other form protecting an equivalent status is fully engaged.

ARTICLE 55: responsibility of the sections

The responsibility of representative sections is engaged by their own actions et operations in the limit of their ability and according to the status, the Charter and other inner regulations.

The responsibility of constituted sections is fully engaged in the limits of what does not depend any more upon their action or ability according to the status, the Charter and other inner regulations.

L. LOSS OF THE QUALITY OF MEMBER

ARTICLE 56: loss of the quality of member

The quality of personal member is lost in case of :

- written resignation or resignation registered by Internet,
- expulsion decided by a national section or by the Board of Directors in case non respect of the regulations or a serious offence,
- death.

The quality of member as production company is lost in case of :

- written resignation or resignation registered by Internet,
- expulsion decided by a national section or by the Board of Directors in case non respect of the regulations, of concluded agreements or financial engagements,
- bankruptcy.

The quality of member as buying company is lost in case of :

- written resignation or registered by Internet,
- the expulsion decided by a national section or by the Board of Directors in case non respect of the regulations, of concluded agreements or financial engagements, obvious speculations on the delivered products, etc,
- bankruptcy.

The quality of member as NGO or affiliated organization is lost in case of :

- written resignation sent to the national section or to BePangea International

- expulsion decided by a national section or by the Board of Directors in case non respect of the regulations, of concluded agreements or financial engagements, obvious speculations on the delivered products, etc,
- bankruptcy.

The quality of member of the Committee of Ethic is lost in case of :

- written resignation to the Board of Directors
- participation to a trading operation remunerated or commissioned by BePangea,
- expulsion decided by a national section or by the Board of Directors in case of serious offence,
- expulsion decided b the general assembly,
- death.

ARTICLE 57: loss of the quality of member as constituted national section

The quality of member as constituted national section may be lost on decision of the Board of Directors in case of serious offence.

The use of the name of BePangea is then prohibited

The Committee of Ethic is then the resort organism.

M. DISSOLUTION OF THE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE 58: dissolution

In case of dissolution, the extraordinary general assembly names one or several liquidators in charge of the liquidation of the properties of the Association, determining their powers of the Association.

The members of the Association cannot pretend to have any part of the properties of the Association, except to be paid back of their financial personal contribution whatever.

The neto remaining assets will be compulsorily distributed to one or several constituted national sections wishing to carry on with their activities, to one or several NGOs preceeded affiliated, or to associations carrying on similar purposes and which will be named by the extraordinary general assembly.

The constituted national sections wishing to carry on their activity will have priority in this distribution.

N. VARIOUS OR COMPLEMENTARY DISPOSITIONS

ARTICLE 59: legal value of the Charter

ARTICLE 60: Inner value of communication and electronic management tools

The members recognize to the communication tools and the economic management used by the Association a legal value in consideration of the character of BePangea and the possibility to use them particularly to:

- hold the General Assemblies,
- organize the votes at the General Assemblies,
- the inner votations,
- holdings of inner decisions,
- administrative treatment of disputes,
- the control of the Committee of Ethic,
- the hierarchical control and the management of the operations of Actions groups.

Their uses cannot not the object of appeals in normal conditions of employment.

ARTICLE 61: official languages of the Association

The official languages of the Association are French and English.

Are in French :

- The status of reference,
- The Charter and its appended regulation of reference
- The register of decisions and modifications of the Association,
- The contracts limited to the French speaking zone as long as a inner example would be held at the disposal or required by the French legislation,
- BePangea puts at disposal on Internet an English translation of the status, the Charter and its appended regulations

Are in English :

- The inner regulations of reference
- The financial regulation of reference
- The holdings of the general Assemblies and their minutes
- The holdings of inner votations
- The electronic of decisions takings process
- All the management and administration tools of the Actions groups under the condition that they would be put at disposal in other languages
- All other documents or contracts having legal or official value.

BePangea puts at the disposal of beneficiaries a French translation of the inner and financial regulations.

The national sections are free to organize their inner activities using any other language providing the documents, correspondences and contracts having legal or official value would strictly be written in English with the exception of French applicable to the operations and actions limited to the French speaking zone.

Translations to French or to English of documents may be required in case of verified necessity.
